MONTHLY REPORT-JUNE 2023

Key Highlights



A total of 563,832 60-kilo bags of coffee valued at US\$ 90.56 million were exported in June 2023 at an average price of US\$ 2.68/kilo US cent 1 lower compared to May 2023 (US \$ 2.69/kilo), and US cents 5 higher than US\$ 2.63/kilo in June 2022. This was an increase of 6.31% and 8.08% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.



Farm-gate prices for Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 4,250 per kilo; FAQ UGX 8,250 per kilo, Arabica parchment UGX 10,500 per kilo and Drugar UGX 9,750 per kilo.





Coffee exports for 12 months (Financial year 2022/23) totaled 5.76 million bags worth US\$ 845.94 million compared to 6.27 million bags worth US\$ 862.28 million the previous year (Financial year 2021/22). This represents a decrease of 8% and 2% in quantity and value respectively.



71% of the total volume was exported by 10 exporters, out of 55 companies which performed during the month compared to 76% in May 2023.

Rwenzori PB fetched the highest price at US \$ 7.65 per kilo.

1. Coffee exports

Coffee exports in June 2023 amounted to 563,832 60-kilo bags, worth US\$ 90.56 million as shown in Fig 1. This comprised 489,597 bags of Robusta valued at US \$ 73.88 million and 74,235 bags of Arabica valued at US\$ 16.68 million (see Table 1 and Annex 1). This was increase of 6.31% and 8.08% in quantity and value respectively compared to the same month last year.

By comparing quantity of coffee exported by type in the same month of last Coffee Year (June 2022), Robusta increased by 10.22% and 21.16% in quantity and value respectively, while Arabica exports decreased by 13.85% and 26.89% in quantity and value respectively.

The monthly coffee exports performance was higher than the previous year which was seen in Robusta exports and was partly on account of a good crop harvest in South-Western region and the prevailing good prices on the global scene which prompted exporters to release their stocks. The decrease in Arabica value was pegged on a likely high output from Brazil in Coffee Year 2023/24 where harvesting is moving at a faster rate due to favourable harvest conditions.

Coffee exports for 12 months (Financial year 2022/23) totaled 5.76 million bags worth US\$ 845.94 million compared to 6.27 million bags worth US\$ 862.28 million the previous year (Financial year 2021/22). This represents a decrease of 8% and 2% in quantity and value respectively. The decrease was pegged on a drought and increasing incidence of pests and diseases in Robusta growing areas and considerable reduction in exports to Sudan in second half of the financial year due to a civil war.

2. Exports by Type and Grade

Table 2 shows coffee exports by type, grade and average realized price for each grade during the month of June 2023. The average export price was US\$ 2.68 per kilo, US cent 1 lower than in May 2023 (US \$ 2.69/kilo). It was 5 US cents higher than in June 2022 (US \$ 2.63/kilo). Robusta exports accounted for 87% of total exports higher than 64% in May 2023. The average Robusta price was US\$ 2.51 per kilo, 19 cents higher than US\$ 2.32 per kilo the previous month. The highest price was for Washed Robusta sold at US \$ 2.88 per kilo, a premium of 19 cents above Screen 18. This was followed by Screen 18 sold at US\$ 2.66 per kilo. Worth noting are lower fair trade prices offered compared to the Conventional grades

The share of Sustainable/washed coffee to total Robusta exports was 1.15% higher than 0.78% in May 2023.

Arabica fetched an average price of US\$ 3.75 per kilo, US cents 7 higher than US\$ 3.68 per kilo realized in May 2023. The highest price was for Rwenzori PB sold at US\$ 7.65 per kilo. It was followed by Rwenzori AA and AB sold at US\$ 7.54 per kilo. Drugar was sold at US\$ 3.62 per kilo, a discount of US cents 48 from Bugisu AA. Drugar exports were 60% of total Arabica exports compared to 42% the previous month.. The share of sustainable Arabica exports to total Arabica exports was 7% the same as in May 2023.



3. Individual Exporter Performance

Figure 2 shows the top 10 export companies' performance in the month of June 2023. Ugacof (U) Ltd had the highest market share of 13.00% compared to 18.12% in May 2023. It was followed by Ideal Quality Commodities Ltd 10.30% (8.83%); Olam Uganda Ltd 9.54% (10.19%) Louis Dreyfus Company (U) Ltd 8.22% (5.54%); Kyagalanyi Coffee Ltd 6.12% (8.64%), Touton Uganda Limited 5.96% (3.70%); Kawacom (U)Ltd 5.17% (6.78%); JBER Coffee Ltd 5.03% (1.93%); Ibero (U)Ltd 3.88% (7.92%); and Grainpulse Ltd 3.42% (1.00%) *The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in May 2023.

The top 10 exporters held a market share of 71% lower that 76% the previous month reflecting increasing competition. Changes in exporter positions compared to last month show competition at this level. Out of the 55 exporters that performed, 24 exported Robusta Coffee only while 10 exported Arabica coffee only. Annex 2 shows a detailed list of exporters' performance in June 2023. Exporter Performance in FY 2022/23 are illustrated in Annex 3.

4. Coffee Exports By Destination

The destinations of Uganda's coffee exports during the month of June 2023 are shown in **Fig 3** (details in **Annex 4**). Italy maintained the highest market share with 37.68% compared to 37.34% last month. It was followed by Sudan 15.77% (7.03%), Germany 12.13% (17.42%), India 7.85% (10.94%) and Belgium 3.85% (3.21%). *The figures in brackets represent percentage market share held in May 2023.

The first 10 major destinations of Uganda coffee took a market share of 90.13% compared to 91.97 % last month. Coffee exports to Africa amounted to 103,285 bags, a market share of 18% compared to 43,777 bags (10%) the previous month. African countries that imported Uganda coffee included Sudan, Morocco, South Africa, Egypt, Madagascar and Kenya. Europe remained the main destination for Uganda's coffees with a 64% imports share, lower than 71% in May 2023.

5. Foreign buyers of Uganda Coffee

Annex 4 shows a list of Ugandan coffee foreign buyers in June 2023. The top 10 buyers held a market share of 64% of total exports, lower than 68% the previous month. Sucafina led with a market share of 13.95% compared to 17.79% in May 2023. It was followed by Olam International 10.28% (10.34%); Louis Dreyfus 8.16% (5.61%); Hamburg Coffee 6.42% (4.29%); Touton Geneve 5.96% (3.70%) Ecom Agro Industrialst 5.40% (7.08%); Altasheel Import & Export Services 4.40%; (1.89%) Bernhard Rothfos 3.88%, (8.37%) Volcafe 3.12% (3.69%) Eurocaf Sas 2.52% (0.63%) Note: The figures in brackets represent percentage performance in the previous month – May 2023.

There were changes in the relative positions of the first 10 major buyers reflecting continued demand for Uganda coffee abroad.

Figure 3: Top ten export destinations by percentage market share




Figure 4: Percentage export share by continent





Figure 5: Top ten buyers by percentage market share



6. Global Situation

World coffee production for 2023/24 is forecast to increase by 4.3 million bags from the previous year to 174.3 million due primarily too higher output from Brazil and Vietnam. Global consumption is forecast at 170.2 million, with the largest gains in the European Union, the United States of America and Brazil. World coffee bean exports are forecast to increase by 5.8 million bags to reach 122.2 million bags higher than 116.4 million fueled by strong shipments from Brazil. Ending stocks are expected to be 31.8 million. (United States Department of Agriculture, Coffee: World Markets and Trade report-June 2023).

7. Local Situation

During the month of June 2023, farm gate prices ranged from Sh.4,000-4,500/= per kilo of Kiboko (Robusta dry cherries); Shs. 8,000-8,500/= for FAQ (Fair Average Quality); Sh. 10,000- 11,000/= for Arabica parchment; and Sh. 9,500-10,000/= per kilo for Drugar from Kasese. Robusta Kiboko averaged UGX 4,250 per kilo; FAQ UGX 8,250 per kilo, Arabica parchment UGX 10,500 per kilo and Drugar UGX 9,750/= per kilo.

8. Coffee Development and Promotional Activities

In the month of June 2023, moderate levels of rain were received in most parts of the country. The rains were characterized by high temperatures. The major pests and diseases incidences recorded included the Black coffee twig borer (BCTB) which is still a major pest in Robusta coffee growing areas. The Red blister disease (RBD) emerged this Financial Year as a major disease in Robusta growing areas. Due to the outbreak of the RBD in hot spot districts of Mukono, Iganga and Mitooma, emergency supply and delivery of agro-inputs were made. At least 165 litres of fertilizer Enhancers, 1,000 kilograms of copper based fungicides and 167 litres of Tebuconazole were provided for demonstration purposes.

Conducted 417 coffee farmer trainings reaching 9,520 farmers (7,533 Male,1,987 Female and 1,339 Youth): 45 in Rwenzori to 835 farmers; 145 in South-western to 1849 farmers; 50 in Western to 1761 farmers; 22 in Elgon to 732 farmers (499 Male ,233 Female,133 Youth); 43 in Eastern to 1217 farmers; 41 in Central to 1531 farmers; 18 in Greater Masaka to 678 farmers and 53 in Northern to 917 farmers. The trainings focused on Good Agricultural Practices (GAPs), renovation and rehabilitation and good post-harvest handling practices.

41 radio talk shows were conducted; 26 in Western region, 1 in Elgon region, 9 in Northern, 4 in Central and 1 in Eastern, mainly focussing on GAPs, post-harvest handling, coffee rehabilitation, coffee value addition, coffee quality management, pests and disease management, sensitization on coffee regulations, the National Coffee Act, 2021, and soil conservation measures. Registrations of coffee value chain actors were recorded as follows: 139 factories, 176 Coffee buying stores; 177 buyers, 2 wet mills, 9 coffee roasters and 13 Exporters. Meanwhile, inspection of primary coffee processing facilities, coffee buying stores, grading factories and roasters were also recorded as follows: 508 factories; 577 stores; 14 roasters and 13 grading facilities. Also, 31 sensitization workshops were conducted for traders and processors. (12 in Greater Masaka, 3 in Eastern, 5 in Western, 6 in Northern, 1 in Rwenzori, 1 in Elgon and 3 in South-western). The sensitizations focused on post-harvest handling and quality preservation.

9. Outlook for July 2023

Coffee exports are projected to be 550,000 bags. The main harvesting season in Greater Masaka and South-Western regions which will be at the tail end.
